We are pleased to announce that, from **February 3 to February 8, 2019**, YCU will offer a 6-day program with a certain scholarship (financial assistance) to learn about planning of sustainable cities from the viewpoint of environment and public health. We offer this opportunity to students of overseas partner institutions with MOUs. The program will be conducted entirely in English language. Program Summary

The “Planning a Sustainable City for the Future: Smart and Inclusive Urban Environment Management in a Super-aged Society” Program offers a great opportunity for international students to learn and study at Yokohama City University which performs modern research for Environment and Public Health in Japan. The goals of the program are to provide a platform to exchange ideas, share problem-solving skills and strengthen international relationships in order to advance progress in the most critical global challenges in the 21st century.

With YCU’s Japanese students and international students from abroad, the participants can enjoy a good opportunity of exchanging ideas with each other, and obtaining global perspective.

What financial assistance (scholarship) YCU will offer?

The YCU financial assistance (scholarship) to be offered to a Tunghai University student:

- (1) The program tuition (i.e., entire lecture fees) will be waived in full.
- (2) YCU will provide free accommodation (twin-room share at a designated hotel) from February 2 (check-in date) to February 9 (check-out date). See “Note” below.
- (3) Travel insurance will be paid by YCU.

The Student has to pay for international air fare, local transportation cost and own meals, etc.

Note: If you wish to extend your stay in Japan beyond February 9 check-out, or before February 2 check-in date, it can be done at your own cost and responsibility. YCU has reserved twin-bed rooms for you at the hotel below from February 2 (Saturday) to February 9 (Saturday) only. During the Program period, one room will be shared by two students.
