## Eligibility

- (1) The program is open to students currently enrolled in any of the Tunghai University Partner Universities and who have been recommended by their respective faculty.
- (2) The program is open to students who possess a beginner's or an intermediate level of Chinese language ability i.e., students who have successfully passed the 3rd level of the TOCFL or HSK. Anyone who have the 4th level of TOCFL is highly likely to feel the Chinese class too easy.
- (3) Students who have good academic records of their affiliated university.

## Application Procedure

- (1) Submit the following documents to THU Office of International Education and Programs:
  - Application Form
  - Passport copy
- (2) Application should be sent by e-mail through the international office of your home institution before deadline.
- (3) Late application is not accepted.

## Cancellation Policy

- (1) Once the program fee has been received, 90% of the program fee will be refunded for a cancellation before the refund date.
- (2) Not refundable after the refund date.

## Accommodation

Student will be arranged to stay at THU Alumni House located on Tunghai campus. Rooms are shared by 2 students with beds, restrooms, shower facilities and air conditioning in each room.
