“Experience of Japanese Culture in Yokohama!” March 4 to March 8, 2019

Overview:

YCU will conduct a 5-day course in 2019 to learn about the Japanese Culture, which is to be provided in Japanese.

Contents:

While experiencing the Japanese traditional performance *Gidayu-bushi*, the participants will learn Japanese traditional culture, traditional stories and the language, and visit a historic town and site. In addition to an opportunity of learning Japanese traditional culture, the course offers the participants opportunities to develop Japanese language skills and exchange with international students and Japanese students.

Target students:

Undergraduate and graduate students who have studied Japanese Language (JLPT; N2 & N3 level) and interests in Japanese culture and society.
