

Former President, Dr. Haydn Chen Revisits Tunghai with Delegation of University of Macau

Vice Rector of University of Macau and former President of Tunghai University (THU), Dr. Haydn H.D. Chen visited Tunghai with 10 professors from 8 residential colleges of University of Macau on December 1, 2014. The welcome reception was hosted by President Ming-Jer Tang with deans from related departments and offices.

This is the first official visit since the signing of Memorandum of University between Tunghai University and University of Macau in 2013. The axis of the visit is to learn more about the very established student labor program in THU and the development of Po-Ya College, which was founded by former President, Haydn Chen. In the welcome briefing, Vice President Chih-Cheng Chao stated that Liberal Arts Education was the founding ideal of Tunghai University. However, as the number of student increased, the ideal gradually became an idea. He credited former President Haydn Chen for reviving the spirit of Liberal Arts Education in Tunghai University and propelling THU to become the representative university of Liberal Arts Education in Taiwan. The delegation of University of Macau later attended a meeting arranged by Office of Student Labor. To gain more understanding on student labor education, the delegation observed students doing labor work on scene.


- The goal of the Student Labor Program is to foster volunteerism and develop students' sense of social responsibility by carrying out environmental services via regular tasks on campus in their daily lives

Hong Kong Lai Kin Catholic Secondary School visited Tunghai University on November 27. Led by Dean of Office of Academic Affairs and three teachers, 32 sophomore and senior students joined the visit. Representing Tunghai University, Director Tzuli Lin of Cross-Strait Division of Office of International Education & Programs (OIEP) held a welcome reception for the visiting teachers and students. Director Juifen Tang of International Student Affairs Division, OIEP introduced different ways to study in Taiwan, counseling services for overseas students and student activities on campus. After the reception, current overseas students in THU gave visiting teachers and students a campus tour and an exceptional experience of the unique ecosystem of Tunghai University.

For SUSE, there are around 2000 faculty and staffs, 28,000 undergraduates, and 600 graduate students.
