Exchange Student Program for Fall 2016

1. Language Requirement

All nominated students who are from Spain, Croatia, Australia, Taiwan and Vietnam have to meet at least one of the following language requirements.

- A. JLPT N4 or higher
- B. Recommendation letter to prove the students' language level is equivalent to JLPT N4

2. Faculty/Department

The students will be automatically placed into Faculty/Department of Global Communication. However, they can take academic courses from other departments depends on their language level. Their academic advisor will help them to decide the course registration after their arrival.

3. Ariake and Musashino Campus

Musashino University has two campuses and each campus offers different academic courses.
